be redistributed accordingly






Will there points for amounts less than ₱20k given in the scholarship grants?

Yes, there will be proportionate points for grants less than ₱20k




# REDISTRIBUTION OF SCORES

CRITERION	Percentage	5,000 pts
1) SCHOLARSHIP GRANT & ADOPT A SCHOLAR	35%	1,750 pts
<i>Amounts provided for Senior High School / College /TechVoc / ALS scholarship grant / adopt a scholar</i>		
<b>Less than 20K = proportionate points will be allotted</b>		
- 20K - 50K	60% = 1,050 points	123 pts
- up to 100K	70% = 1,225 points	245 pts
- up to 150K	80% = 1,400 points	368 pts
- up to 200K	90% = 1,575 points	490 pts
- above 200K	100% = 1,750 points	613 pts






The reporting will be based on the actual funds disbursed from July 1 – March 31, 2022.

Although the current points for the working scholars is limited to 500pts (50pts per girl), considerations can be made once the report of the club has been submitted.



*Providing workshops or seminars for specific knowledge or skills training (for scholars / parents/teachers etc)* 50 pts per class in the club level & 100 points per class in the district level

- 1% per classes (minimum of 7 participants) offered (internal club)
- 2% per class (minimum of 7 participants) offered (within district)

4) EDUCATIONAL BOOSTER	50 pts per scholar	5% 250 pts
<i>Removing learning obstacles by providing necessary items for learning like computers &amp; tablets, internet load, learning materials, tools of the trade or providing payment for college preparation exams/entrance exams or review centers for licensure. - 1% per scholar</i>		
5) SPECIAL/FOCUSED CLASSES	for women and girls only	15% 750 pts
<i>Providing workshops or seminars for specific knowledge or skills training (for scholars / parents/teachers etc)</i>		
<i>50 pts per class club level or 100 pts per class district</i>		
<i>- 1% per classes (minimum of 7 participants) offered (internal club)</i>		
<i>- 2% per class (minimum of 7 participants) offered (within district)</i>		
6) MENTORING & MONITORING		15% 750 pts
<i>Providing mentoring and monitoring services to scholars</i>		
<i>Evidence: Report on at least 4 mentoring sessions, updates on scholars welfare and wellbeing (enrollment status/grades?) - maximum of 15%</i>		
7) CLUB INITIATED PROJECT/ACTIVITY		10% 500 pts
<i>Providing initiatives that are aligned with the rational and objectives of the ATE program but is different from what was indicated above. (This may include but not limited to sponsoring educational fieldtrips/exchange programs for SHS/College). - maximum 10%</i>		
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>100%</b>	<b>5,000 pts</b>
