



1. The application for grant is limited to the following ATE initiatives:

- Allowance for a Collegíate Level Academíc Scholar
- Allowance for a TVET* Scholar
- Financial assistance (via enrollment) for a Review Class/Program in preparation for the Board Exam under the Educational Booster initiative




POLICY

- 2. The scholarship recipient must not have any other scholarship grants from other organizations.
- Application for grant must be limited to two (2) individuals per club regardless of the initiative.




POLICY

4. Clubs are required to submit a progress report on the recipient (i.e., mid-year or mid-program report, year-end or end of program report; & submit pertinent documents like grades, enrollment receipt, and certificate of completion).




Availability of grants are as follows:

 The allowance for the Collegiate Level Academic Scholarship grant is for a maximum of one (1) academic school year at ₱1,500 per month for 10 months. The total maximum amount available for one (1) recipient is ₱15,000.




Availability of grants are as follows:

The allowance for the TVET
 Scholarship grant is good for one (1) certificate program at ₱750 per month. Total maximum amount for one (1) recipient is ₱9,000.




Availability of grants are as follows:

3. The financial assistance under the Booster Program is provided towards the cost of one (1) program enrollment in a Review Center. The requested amount is based on the enrollment cost, the maximum amount is ₱10,000.

HOW TO LIQUIDATE FUNDS

Collegiate Academic Scholar



Submit a mid-year and a year-end report indicating the name of the scholar, course, school, and the mentoring activity provided to the scholar. Include a copy of the scholar's grades per term covered by the grant.

HOW TO LIQUIDATE FUNDS

Submit a mid and end-program report (if program is more than 5 mos.) or end-program report (if less than 5 mos.) indicating the name of the scholar, training program, school, and the mentoring activity provided to the scholar. Include a copy of her certificate of completion.

HOW TO LIQUIDATE FUNDS

EDUCATIONAL BOOSTER RECIPIENT



Submit a report at the end of the review program indicating the name of the recipient, review program enrolled in, review center, and the mentoring activity provided to the recipient. Include a copy of the enrollment receipt and possibly her result in the Board Exam.
