SOROPTIMIST INTERNATIONAL OF PINES CITY

The Soroptimist International of Pines City was conceived by women with impeccable personality and resources, sensitive to the needs and welfare of women and girls in the home, the community, in business and the country. The Club was chartered by SI Philippines Region Governor Esperanza Alconcel, SI Northern Luzon District Director Nida Vergara and Onesima Bugnosen of SI Baguio on March 22, 1997 at Prime Hotel, Baguio City, with educator and civic leader Dr. Amelia Mapagu as its Charter President. Other Charter members were Feliza Bandonill. Isabelina Ronquillo. Zosima Aguilar, Priscilla Bautista, and Asuncion Gundran.

HEADQUARTERS

Sitting in front of the beautiful tree park of Baguio Convention Center is SIPC's headquarters. Formally recognizing the Club's valuable contributions to the City since its inception, the City Government of Baguio, in cooperation with the Philippine Tourism Authority, awarded SIPC the use of the Information Center along UP Drive as its headquarters through a duly-signed memorandum of agreement during the term of Honorable Mayor Braulio Yaranon.

OUTSTANDING WOMEN LEADERS OF BAGUIO

Notably, four of SIPC's past presidents have been presented the City's "Outstanding Women Leaders (OWLs) of Baguio Award" - Dr. Zosima Aguilar and Imelda Bisnar in 2010, Annabelle Estepa in 2011 and Flora Balaba in 2018. The Club has three more OWLs awardees among its current membership (2018-2020). Patricia Anne Gallardo-Marcelo was awarded in 2010; Dr. Maria Aplaten, in 2012; and Jennifer Mejia, in 2016. Imelda Bisnar was Charter President of the Outstanding Women Leaders of Baguio in 2018. Gallardo-Marcelo was recognized by the City as an Outstanding Citizen of Baguio in 2012.

Annabelle Estepa and Imelda Bisnar were the most Outstanding Presidents of SI Philippines Region during their terms.
