Introduction:

Through the *Unsung Women Heroes Awards*, Soroptimist International of the Americas Philippines Region (A Foundation) Inc. endeavors to recognize these nameless women who have made it their life's work to uplift the well-being of other women and girls in their communities. While the Awards cannot possibly celebrate all of these women, Soroptimist hopes to inspire others – both young and old – to pursue similar paths of service.

To pay tribute to ordinary women who have been seeking to make an extraordinary difference in the world, the call for nominations is open to the public.

Eligibility

To be eligible for nomination to the Unsung Women Heroes Awards, women must have worked to advance the interests of women and girls, particularly in the last two (2) years prior to the nomination.

Qualifications:

- 1. A woman, 25 years or older
- 2. A Filipino citizen
- Nominee does not hold any government position nor any position of influence in any well known private organization/corporation/association. Neither is she married to a government official nor to a well known, influential private individual.
- 4. Nominee has not received any national or international award in the past.
- 5. Nominee is well-known for her outstanding volunteer work and may have been recognized in her own community.
- 6. Nominee's outstanding work in her community for the past two years falls under any of the following areas:
 - Generation of economic opportunities to alleviate poverty;
 - Protection of women and girls from abuse, violence or neglect;
 - Creation of opportunities for the education of women and girls;
 - Improvement of the living conditions or indigenous groups;
 - Advancement of women's reproductive health rights; and
 - Enhancement of women's political participation in the community.
- 7. Please include two (2) photographs (2x2) of nominee.
- 8. Soroptimists and their immediate family as well as employees of any SI club are disqualified from applying/or being nominated for these awards.
